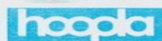

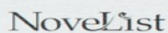
**Canadian Newsstream** Contains scholarly journals, books, videos & audio, newspapers, magazines that provides full text format to current Canadian news content including Alberta dailies and weeklies. Guidance and help are available on home page



**Cloud Library** An innovative method to browse, borrow and read eBooks or listen to audiobooks. Browse the featured carousels or browse the digital shelves filtered by fiction or non-fiction by age and category. App is available.



**hoopla** Hoopla is a streaming digital service that offers ebooks, audiobooks, comics, music, movies and TV shows that can be enjoyed on your PC, table, phone or TV. Available immediately with a 2 item limit. Also available in KIDS mode.



**Novelist, Novelist K-8 or Novelist Plus** can help you find your next read. Browse items by 'I'm in the mood for books that are...' genres or award winners. Recommended reading lists are also available by age, fiction/non-fiction and category.



**Overdrive** offers a selection of ebooks and audiobooks. Be sure to check out the Lucky Day Reads and Lucky Day Audio for items that require no wait time. Libby App is available. Browse the carousels or by subject.



**Press Reader** is an all you can read digital newsstand. Select newspaper or magazine by country, language or alphabetically. Press Reader's mission is to improve the way people discover stories that matter. App available.



**RBdigital** provides access to audiobooks, magazines and comics carousels for browsing or select +EXPLORE to filter selections further. App available.



**Read Alberta eBooks** has both eBooks and audiobooks by language, release date, audience and category in the catalogue tab or in the home tab find a recent release. A featured selection is the **Prairie Indigenous eBook Collection**, the first of its kind in Canada. The collection increases access to stories by Indigenous authors and writing about Indigenous culture.



**Tumblebooks** are created by adding animation, sound, music and narration to picture books creating an electronic picture book that you can read or have read to you. No limits and no waiting. Start the joy of lifelong reading, listening and learning with this resource for kids. Create playlists.
