### **COVID-19 Library Update**



The library is back to as normal as we can get it right now. We are going to keep our Covid hours for at least one more month - just to see how back to school goes.

If you are exhibiting either a fever, cough, or shortness of breath, please do not enter the library. Upon arriving at the library, we ask that you sanitize at the door. We do have masks available, but we don't require you to wear one. However, the librarian

will be wearing a face shield. There is NO public washroom available at this time. If you remove a book from the shelf and decide you don't want it, please place it on a table assigned for that reason. All returned material will be quarantined for a minimum of 72 hours. There is one computer available for public use and will be sanitized after each use. Surfaces and door handles are also sanitized on a regular bases. Please let me know if there is something we can do on our end to make your visit more comfortable.

The majority of programs are still not happening. If we think we are able to continue and keep our distance we will consider moving ahead with that program. 
