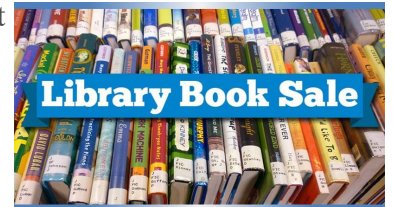

### BOOK SALE

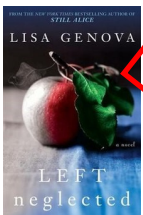
We have deleted a lot of books from our shelves during this pandemic. Due to covid guidelines, we will display only a few boxes at a time.

The first Monday of the month, we will have a new display. Stop by and purchase some books at great prices.



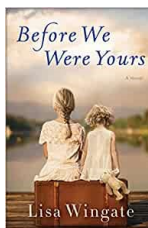

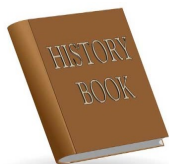


The 2021 Community Birthday calendars have arrived and available for pick up. You may pick them up at the library during regular hours or contact me and I will direct you in the right direction.

If you or know someone that would be willing to take on this endeavor, please contact the library and we will investigate if there is enough interest.

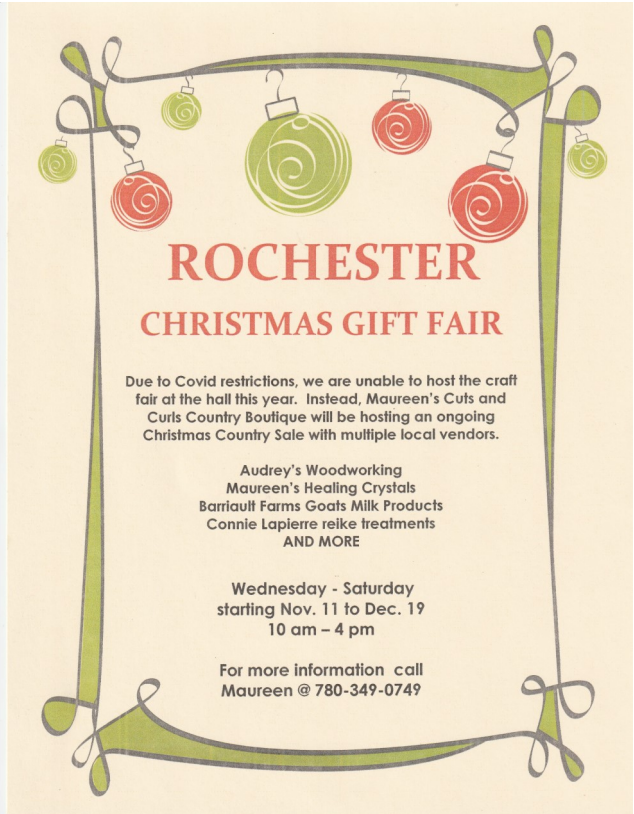
## TECHNOLOGY HELP
