COVID-19 LIBRARY UPDATE

GOOD NEWS!! WE ARE OPEN!!

Effective March 8, our doors have been open to the public with the standard COVID procedures in place. Masks are mandatory. Sanitize upon entering the library. No public washrooms available. Books being returned will need to be quarantined for 72 hrs, so will still show on your account until check-in. Unfortunately, we still are unable to hold in-person programming.

Curb-side service will still be available for those that wish. Just give me a call during library hours and we can make arrangements. *NOTE: new hours!

USING YOUR TRACPAC APP

Place a hold on any book and it will be delivered to the library for you to pickup. Here's how!

Log in to www.tracpac.ab.ca


1. Select **MY ACCOUNT**. Type in your 14 digit library barcode and your 4 digit password (PIN) - contact the library if you don't have your card.

2. Search for a title

3. Select the title you want

4. Select **Place Request**, this will require you to select or verify your **Pickup Library** and click on **submit request**.

It will be shipped to the library and I will contact you for pickup. Any questions, please don't hesitate to contact me.





NO SCHOOL


Just a reminder: when the school is closed for any reason (ie. spring break), the library remains open during its regular days/hours unless it is a statutory holiday.


