

ROCHESTER SCHOOL - INTENT TO REGISTER

To improve the accuracy of enrolment projections for Rochester School, Aspen View Public Schools requests information from Rochester-area families regarding pre-school aged (0-5 years) children whom they intend to register in Rochester School in the coming years.


